Grades 7, 8 & 9

- minimum of **15 Philanthropy hours** annually for both TeamMate & Coaches.
- minimum of **6 League hours** annually for both TeamMate & Coaches.

Grades 10, 11 & 12

- minimum of **10 Philanthropy Hours** annually for both TeamMate & Coaches.
- minimum of **6 League Hours** annually for both TeamMate & Coaches.
